This application is for affordable unassisted units at two apartment complexes in Chelmsford: The Kensington Apartments and The Commons at Drum Hill. A portion of one & two bedroom units at both of these complexes have been deemed 'affordable' and as such command a lower than market rent.

Applicant's income must be under 50% of median income (*see table on back page*). Preference is given to local Chelmsford residents. *Section 8 voucher holders may also apply*.
