Marcaurelle, seconded by F. Ramseyer. On a motion by F. Ramseyer, seconded by D. Marcaurelle, the board also voted unanimously to formalize additional bonuses for staff in the amount of \$21,250. On a motion by D. Marcaurelle, seconded by F. Ramseyer, it was voted unanimously to accept the ED Reports.

- 1.) Review and approve budget revision for DHCD for FY20. On a motion by D. Marcaurelle, seconded by F. Ramseyer, it was voted unanimously to increase the state budget by \$33,879.
- 2.) Review and approve vacation buyback. On a motion by D. Marcaurelle, seconded by F. Ramseyer, it was voted unanimously to approve a buyback of vacation time due to the Covid 19 pandemic in the amount of \$56,205.
- 3.) Review and approve write-off of back rent for Section 8 participant in the amount of \$3,795.00. On a motion by D. Marcaurelle, seconded by F. Ramseyer, it was voted approve the write-off.
